We are currently in the process of putting together a new set of policies and procedures regarding special events or functions taking place daily on campus. We would like to implement a print at home pass as we do with our football games, however there are some draw backs and we are wondering what other Universities may be doing to get past those.

Because these are special events and entry is not monitored, they would only be checked or validated when a PEO was in the location doing routine enforcement. For that reason we could see where there may be room for abuse by copying the permit. If we mandate that a license plate and description be tied to the permit it could create extra work for the PEO's to validate and for conference organizers and guests.

Any thoughts or suggestions on how you handle these type situations would be appreciated.
