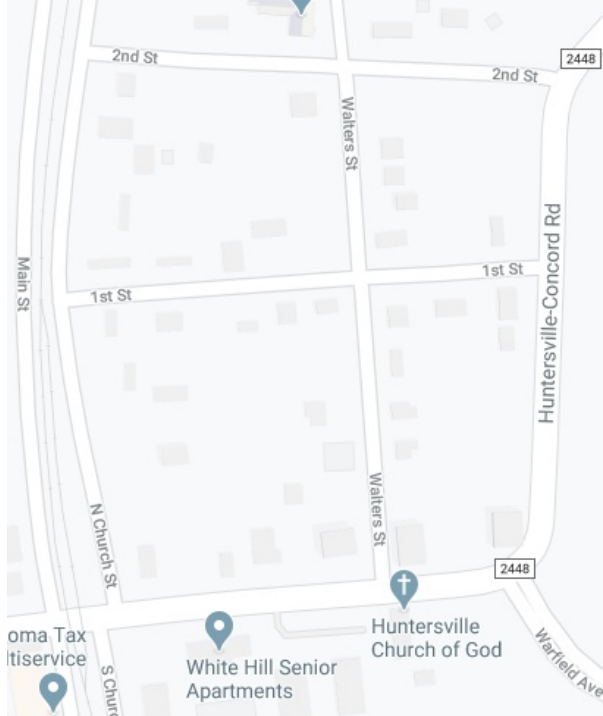

I enjoyed our conversation yesterday. This is the information you requested. I hope I explained it good enough to give you a better idea of each area. I thought it best to take a map shot of the areas, so you would see how the streets are positioned, instead of only having the street names.

If HPD can be of assistance in your outreach program, please let me know.

Town Central... 1st, 2nd and Walters Street (to include White Hill Senior Apts). All areas are off of Huntersville Concord Road and predominately Hispanic in the single homes. White Hill Apts are mixed use, but all are on a fixed income (we helped a few out with our Christmas Project this year).



North Town Center... Bigham Street north to Ramah Church Road between NC 115 (Statesville Road) and Glendale Dr. (predominately white/Hispanic)

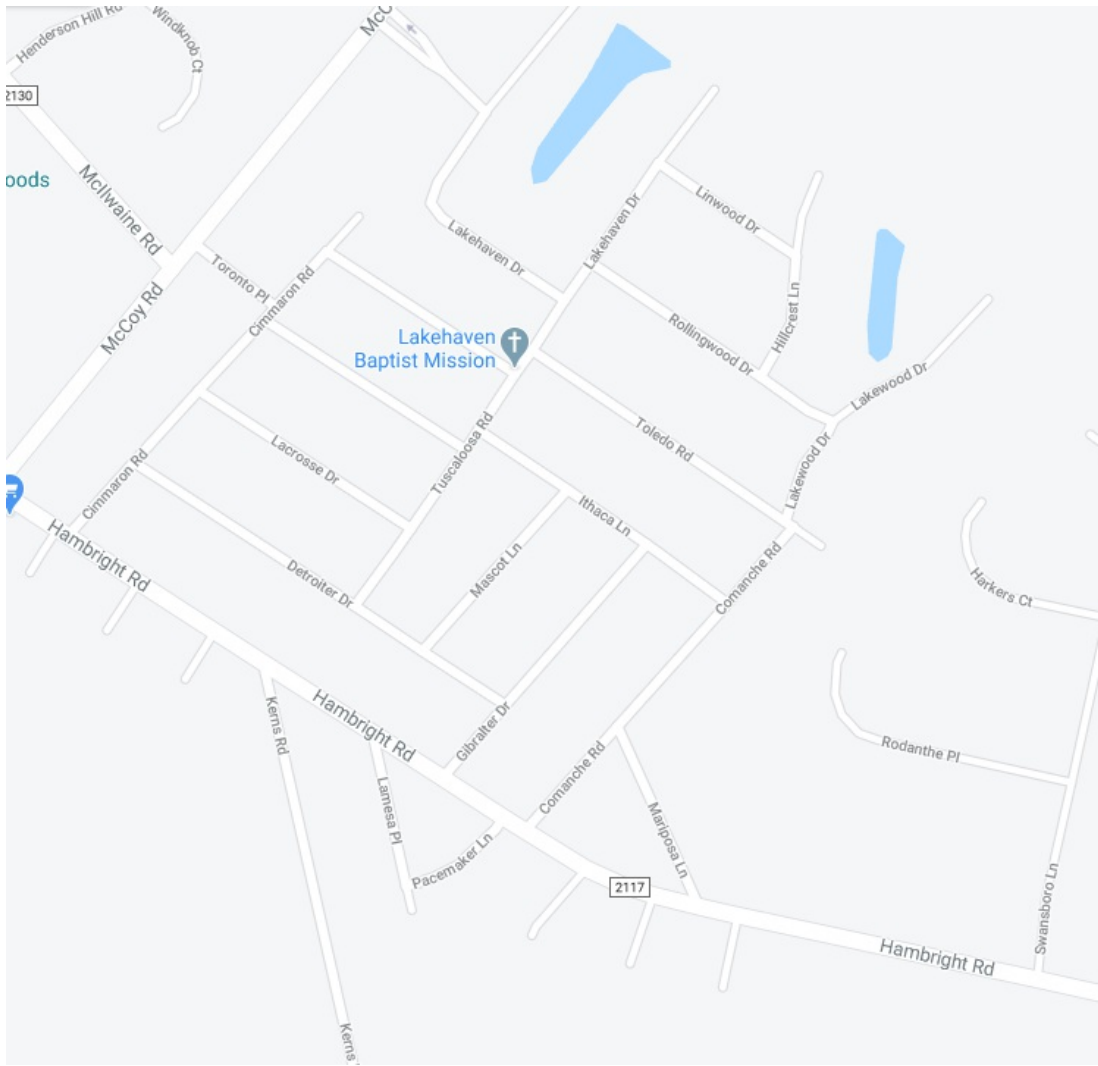


South Town Central... These areas are commonly referred to as the Dellwood, Holbrooks or Potts Town area. It has always been predominately African American and low middle to low income (excluding Drake Hill Drive, which is the back part of Vermillion). The streets are Gibson Park, Baucom Ln, parts of S Church Street, Dellwood, Sherrwynn Ln, Whispering Pines Ln, Central Ave, David Street, Holbrooks, New Haven





This area is predominately Hispanic though it is a mixed area (middle to low income). It is a squared off area between McCoy Road and Hambright Road; although, there are a few homes along the south side of Hambright Road. This area also includes the homes off of Swansboro Lane (Henderson Hill off of McIlwaine is not included in this area).



This area is predominately African American and is middle to low income. However, in recent years newer homes have been built in the area. It's less densely populated than the other areas. It is off of Hambright Road (left and right) just before you get to Beatties Ford.



This area is predominately white and is low income, however in recent years newer homes have been built in the area. It's less densely populated than the other areas. It is off of McIlwaine Road between McCoy Road and Beatties Ford.



This area is predominately African American and is middle to low income, however in recent years newer homes have been built in the area. It is off of Beatties Ford, north of Hopewell High School. Most of the area runs off of the main road (Neck Road).

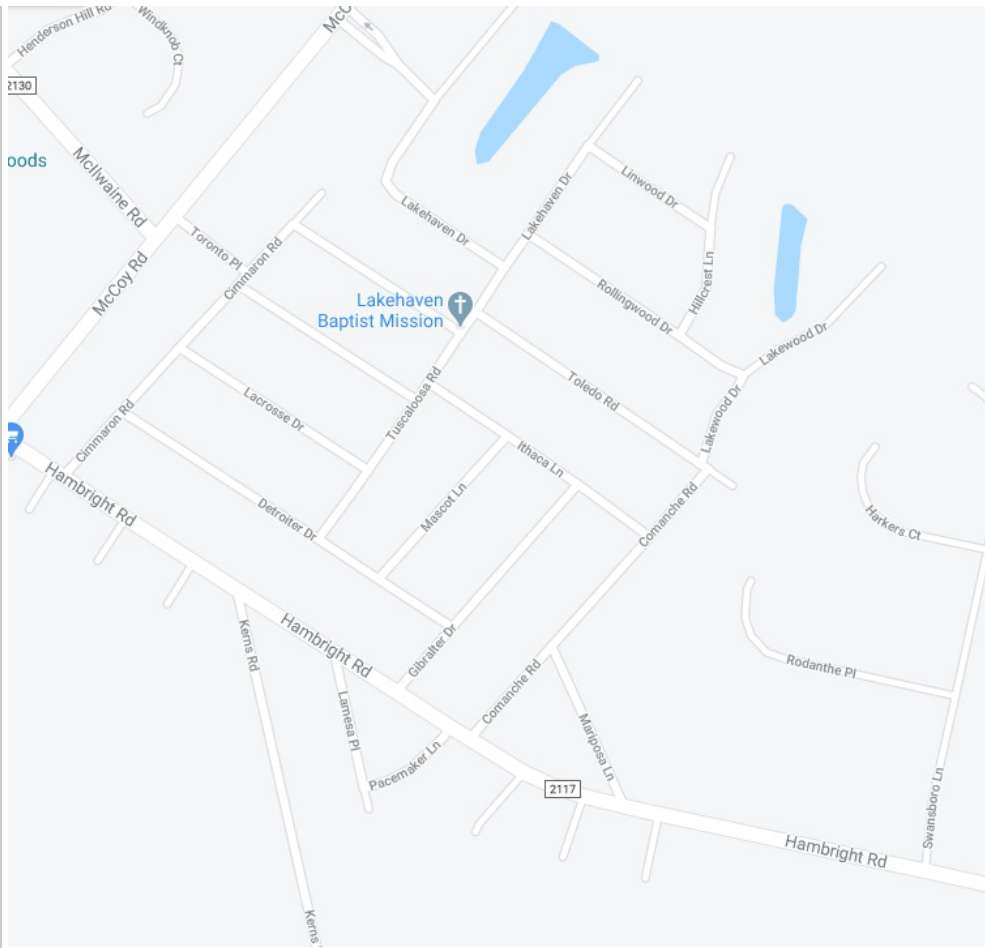
North Town Center... Bigham Street north to Ramah Church Road between NC 115 (Statesville Road) and Glendale Dr. (predominately white/Hispanic)
